
Post legislative changes, the Monitor will be required to report on the performance of all agencies that provide services to children in the Oranga Tamariki system which includes the early intervention, statutory care, protection, youth justice and transitions support systems as outlined in the Oranga Tamariki Act 1989, and also other agency services provided to children and young people under the Act (for example health, education and disability services, including by NGOs). It also includes services provided by Children's Agencies to the core populations of interest to Oranga Tamariki as defined under the Children's Act 2014, including children who have early risk factors for future involvement in the statutory care, protection and youth justice systems regarding the state of care.
